Virginia's Black, Indigenous, and People of Color Historic Preservation Grant Fund Project Review Criteria

To be eligible for the grant program:

- Project must meet the minimum requirements for the grant program as set out in the <u>Grant Manual</u> including an eligible project applicant and type and National Register and/or Virginia Landmarks Register eligibility
- Project must meet or be able to meet the <u>Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the</u> Treatment of Historic Properties
- Projects that are connected to historic and archaeological sites of importance associated with Virginia's Black, Indigenous, and People of Color communities
- Project outcomes must be clear and feasible.

Priority will be given to:

- Projects that have clear and demonstrated community involvement and/or support (can include community groups, decedent groups, alumni groups, etc.)
- Projects with a direct and specific connection to BIPOC community/s
- Projects that are shovel ready with at least initial planning documents completed
- Projects that address a specific threat (vacant, climate, development, etc.)
